when she was 6 years old. She is a student of the Secondary Music School of Zenon

Brzewski in Warsaw in the violin class of Prof. Agnieszka Cypryk. She performs as a soloist as well as in chamber ensembles in Poland and abroad.

She performed as a soloist at the Royal Castle in Warsaw, in the Palace on the Isle in the Royal Łazienki, at the National Philharmonic in Warsaw, at the Warmińsko-Mazurska Philharmonic and at the Chopin University of Music in Warsaw, Krzysztof Penderecki European Centre for Music, in Rome, with chamber ensembles in Venice and Padua, in Polish Radio Katowice with Chamber Orchestra „Archetti”, in „Nowa Miodowa” concert hall with Sinfonia Iuventus.

She also takes part in masterclasses in Poland and abroad.

She is a laureate of over 70 national and international competitions. Her greatest achievements over the past two years include:
